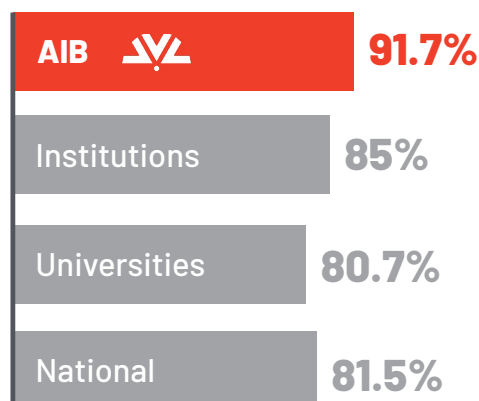


AIB proudly achieved the highest overall satisfaction score among 77 participating universities and institutions.

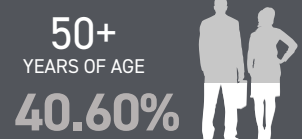
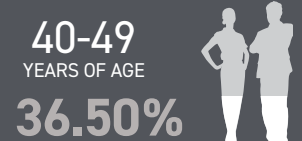
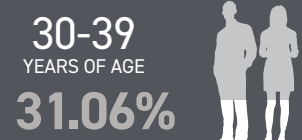
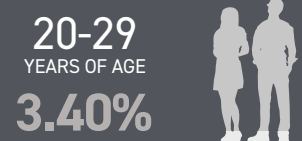
ALUMNI WORK STATUS

ACCESSIBLE ENTRY

AIB'S PRACTICAL ENTRY CRITERIA TAKES INTO ACCOUNT APPLICANT'S WORK EXPERIENCE AND PRIOR EDUCATION

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants who wish to undertake The Fast-Track MBA must meet the minimum criteria for the first stage of the MBA - Graduate Certificate in Management.

A MINIMUM OF FIVE YEARS OF RELEVANT WORK EXPERIENCE

Which includes at least three years of management experience or significant technical experience.

OR

A BACHELOR'S DEGREE +2YRS

(AQF Level 7) and at least two years of relevant work experience.

OR

AN ADVANCED DIPLOMA ASSOCIATE DEGREE +3YRS

(AQF Level 6) or learning equivalent to an AQF Level 6 qualification and at least three years of relevant work experience.

OR

MINIMUM GMAT SCORE OF 550

Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) with a minimum score of 550 and at least three years of relevant work experience.

RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING

You may be eligible to earn an MBA faster by leveraging your existing qualifications. If you currently hold a qualification in a business-related field, you could use AIB's Credit Transfer policy to recognise your prior achievement, helping you earn an MBA faster, for less.

ENGLISH REQUIREMENTS

For applicants from non-English speaking regions and/or who have studied in a foreign language, AIB has an English language proficiency requirement that needs to be met in order to be accepted into the MBA. Speak to your Course Advisor about the variety of ways your English language proficiency can be demonstrated.

TECHNICAL AND COMPUTER REQUIREMENTS

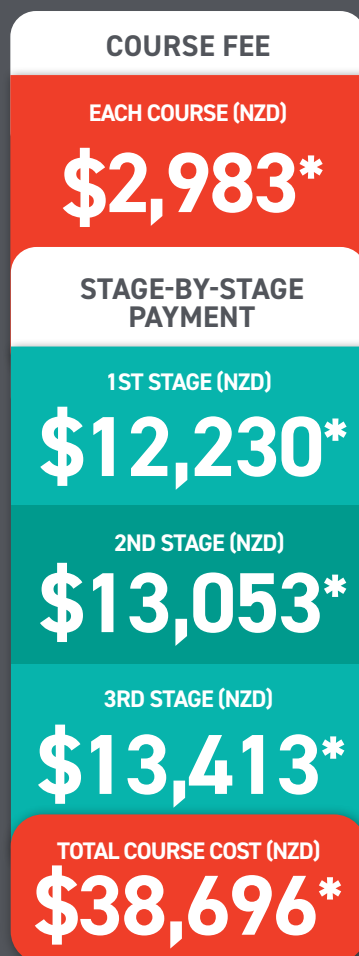
